Car park opened

We are delighted that the temporary car park on The Turnstones is now open, providing additional parking for people using the shops until the permanent car park is ready. A parking management company has been appointed on behalf of Watford Community Housing, and their signage will be displayed on site. The new pedestrian crossing on The Gossamers will be completed soon. In the meantime, users are advised to use the existing pedestrian crossing.

Post box installed

Following the pavement works outside the York Way parade, a brand-new post box has now been installed outside the Post Office.

Progress continues on The Turnstones

The final bungalow along York Way has now been completed and works continue at pace to the rest of the properties off The Turnstones. We are expecting the properties on Kingfisher Way and The Turnstones to be completed this summer. The six properties on The Turnstones feature off-street parking, with further parking available along Kingfisher Way, and behind access-controlled gates.

Highway works update

Works to pavements along The Turnstones are nearing completion, with only the final 'wearing' course to be laid outside the new houses on The Turnstones. The contractors will then begin works to the area of land opposite The Phillipers, which has been delayed awaiting Thames Water's approval of amended drainage designs. This next phase of works will then continue towards the York Way parade and will last for approximately four to six weeks.
