Upgrading your heating

Kensa are continuing to make progress with the works to install the new heating system for Abbey View, Munden View and the nearby low-rise blocks, which will provide reliable heating and hot water for residents.

Temporary car park update

We are pleased to say that our plans to implement a temporary car park are progressing well.

We will be using the large field by the main car park as a temporary car park to make sure we keep as many spaces open as possible while the works take place. The proposed location is shown on the map at the end of this newsletter.

During the week commencing **15 May 2025**, Kensa are aiming to move their equipment out of the east car park into the large field, opening up that car park again for all residents to use.

We are aiming to open the temporary car park from the week commencing **15 May 2025**. The whole main car park will then be closed for further works, as scheduled.

There will be a one-way system in place to ease congestion and access to the car park will be managed to ensure everything runs smoothly.

Please rest assured that we are doing all we can to ensure the works are carried out as quickly as possible, to keep disruption to a minimum.
